Holy Gospel Matthew 18:1–11

¹At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" ²And calling to Him a child, He put Him in the midst of them ³ and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, vou will never enter the kingdom of heaven. 4Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
