

- ► MEETING THIS WEEK: The Parish Planning Committee will meet this Tuesday, October 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 pm.
- ₩ ROOF REPAIR: At the last meeting, the council took action to schedule the repair on a section of the church roof. This was an unplanned expense, but a concern with the upcoming winter that if not addressed it would lead to more problems. The expected cost is between \$33,000 \$35,000. We are blessed with current fund reserves Capital Improvements Fund (\$13,150) and LCEF Savings (\$46,011.12). This expense will make a significant cut to these reserves and as we approach the end of the year, we ask you to prayerfully consider how your personal stewardship might help us restore these critical funds. Please designate additional contributions for this as Capital Improvements.
